Engagement with WFP China COE

Country Offices are encouraged to put forward their South-South Cooperation (SSC) initiative/ concept note /proposal under the framework of the Four Thematic Areas within the Three Modalities of WFP China COE.

Four Thematic Areas:

·Value Chain Development for Smallholders

•Post-harvest Loss Management and Food Systems

•Disaster Risk Reduction and Climate Change Resilience

·Innovative Poverty Alleviation Initiative

What are the Six Steps?

Step ONE on SSC Demand:

Country Office proposes initiative/concept note/proposal (or through Regional Bureau) to China Centre of Excellence for Rural Transformation.

Step TWO on SSC Supply:

China Centre of Excellence for Rural Transformation reviews the initiative and conduct consultation including discussions with Chinese partners.

Step THREE on SSC Match:

China Centre of Excellence for Rural Transformation works together with HQ, Regional Bureau and Country Office to identify technical support, expertise, and resources.

Step FOUR on SSC Endorsement:

Country Office enters into agreement on SSC engagement with China Centre of Excellence for Rural Transformation and Chinese government partners.

Step FIVE on SSC Implementation:

China Centre of Excellence for Rural Transformation supports implementation by facilitating expert recruitment and dispatch, coordinate capacity development activities, and conduct technical cooperation.

Step SIX on SSC Feedback:


China Centre of Excellence for Rural Transformation works together with Country Office to review and summarize, collect feedback, and picture follow-ups for further actions/ scaling-ups if needed.

Three Modalities:

P – Policy dialogue, including roundtable, seminar, high-level visit, thematic-research, webinar, etc.;

T – Technical cooperation, including exchange visit, workshop, study tour and DAA (Demonstration in Africa/Asia/Latin America by Africans/Asians/Latin Americans);

K –Knowledge Sharing Platform to showcase China's policy reference, successful experience of Chinese farmers and pragmatic technologies.
